Spring 1 Learning



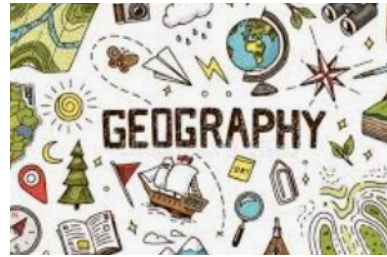

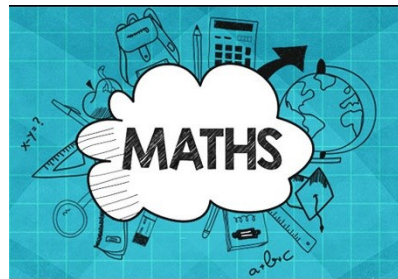
Our PE session will be on a **THURSDAY** this half term. They will build on their knowledge of previous years dance skills.



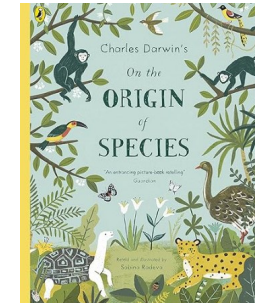
In RSHE, the children will learn how the media can influence people.
