<p>Getting lost</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Will we get detention for being late if we get lost/can't find it quickly enough? • Is there a one-way system? If yes, do you have to go the long way if it is next door? • Which way do you get in and get out? Is there a separate entrance and exit? 	<p>No</p> <p>There is a one way system and we walk on the left.</p> <p>There are many entrances and exits</p>
<p>Being bullied</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • What do I do if I am being bullied? • What happens to the bully? • I have been told that 'snitches get stitches' is this true? • Lots of concerns about fights and getting hurt / people carrying knives • Worried about older children forcing them to do drugs • Worried about going to the toilets at lunch if older children are in there / worried about finding older girls intimidating 	<p>Talk to your tutor or student support</p> <p>They will be punished using the consequences system</p> <p>No</p> <p>Not true. People who fight are usually excluded. If someone brought a knife to school they would be permanently excluded</p> <p>Talk to student support or tutor</p> <p>Year 7 & 8 have lunch together. The rest of the school have lunch at a different time.</p>
<p>Lunchtime</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do the year 11s push past the year 7s at lunch times? • Do you queue separately at lunch time if you are sandwiches? • Is it true that the year 11s take over the football pitch? Is there a rota for playing football? Can we bring our own football/gloves etc. We're a bit worried about getting hit really hard with the football by older children. • Can you leave school at lunch time to go to the shops? • If you forget your lunch, what do you get to eat? • Do you need to bring sandwiches? What food does school offer? • Do we all have separate times for lunch/break? • Where do you have to eat? Inside and outside? • Where do you put your bag at lunchtime? • When you are eating, do you have to have a healthy snack? Ensure 5 a day? 	<p>No</p> <p>No –same queue for everyone</p> <p>No. There are many football pitches to go on – lots of space.</p> <p> </p> <p>No</p> <p>Talk to student support – they will help</p> <p>Your choice. Phones <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At lunch, can you go on your phone? • Can you call people at break? • Do you ever get to use phones in lessons? • Can you use your phone in school? • What would happen if your phone beeped or vibrated in a lesson? • Is there wifi at the school? Are you allowed to connect to it? • What if someone steals your phone? 	You are not allowed your phone ANYWHERE on the school site. You can have a phone on you for the journey to and from school but when you arrive at school it must be switched off and in your blazer. If it is seen or heard AT ANY TIME during the day it will be immediately confiscated and you will be put into isolation for the rest of the day. If someone steals your phone we will do our best to find it for you.
Being off school <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If you are poorly, will we get set work to do at home? 	It depends how long you are away from school. If you have a lengthy illness then you will be set work to do.
Friendships <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Scared I won't make any new friends (going to CIW – people do know are in different houses, not many from PJS going). • If you are in different tutor groups/houses or classes, will you get to see other friends? 	You will make lots of friends in the first few weeks. Everyone is mixed up into groups and you will be working with lots of new people.
Uniform <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • are you allowed to wear trousers as a girl? • what has to have the logo? • what do I need to wear? If I am missing something, will I get into trouble? ie forgotten tie? • can you wear summer dresses? • can boys wear shorts if it's hot? • What if I outgrow my school shoes? • How much are the uniform items? 	<p>Yes Blazer/School jumper (if you wear one)/PE kit See the school website. Rules and punishments <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • What are the punishments at school? What do you get punished for? • What happens if you get the wrong answer in lessons? 	<p>See the school website</p> <p>Nothing. You will be encouraged to try again.</p>

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • What happens in detention? What happens if you are silly in detention? 	<p>You work in silence. If you are silly you will get a day in isolation (8:30 – 4 p.m.)</p>
Homework <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Will we get homework straight away? • How much homework do you get? • What happens if you don't do the homework? • What is the usual amount of time do you have to do your homework ie a week, next day? • What happens if you forget the homework on the due date? • What happens if you have lost your homework? • Is most of the homework paper-based or on-line? 	<p>Yes You get one homework from each subject once every two weeks Usually a few days or a week Detention (30 mins) See your teacher and ask for a replacement Mixture</p>
Lessons <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • PE – can you request what to learn next? • PE – do you change in a private area or is it in front of everyone? • Do we get to go to Carlton Forum? • Different buildings for different subjects – is there a set way to get there or can you just go directly? • What do you do in tutor group? Who is in there with you? • How many lessons a day? • Do you have a set place at the desk in every class? • What do you do in Art and PE lessons? 	<p>No Changing room with other pupils Clear paths around school to follow.
