

Welcome Back!

It is really great to have the school full of children again we are all very glad to see you all returned safely. We welcome our new Year 3's to Priory who we are so proud of for settling so well as they had not had an opportunity to visit us before the summer. We also welcome Mrs Simpson, teaching assistant in Year 4 and are thrilled she has joined us as one of the team. We as you know are having to work in a different way presently, in a way that we would not normally wish to but we want to keep everyone Covid safe and so we ask you to please follow our new routines.

Start and finish of day- Please could we remind you that the window between 8.50 -9.00 in the morning and 3.05pm in the afternoon is for **Year 3 and 6** to arrive and the window between 9.00-9.10 in the morning and 3.15 in the afternoon is for **Year 4 and 5**. This is to make it easier to social distance at the school gates and stagger children coming into the building. I know it is difficult if you have children in different windows but if you in that case aim to arrive at 9am that will help you and us and if other families aim to arrive for 8.50 or 9.10 that will minimise the volume of people at the gates at any one time. Thank you for your co-operation and patience with this. **Please avoid turning your car around in 2nd Avenue as we now have more children entering by that entrance.**

Visitors in school- we are trying to minimise visitors onto the site. Please avoid coming to the reception unless it is an emergency to protect your health but also the health of our office team. All queries can be texted in to the system or you can call the office. If you need a longer discussion or have a specific issue that can't be resolved by a call or text please call or text to make an appointment. **Please be aware we may need to hold the appointment virtually or over the phone.**

Water bottles- children can not use the water fountains so please ensure they bring water to school every day.

P.E – to avoid the potential mix up of uniform and to avoid changing in close proximity we ask that children arrive on their P.E day in kit and remain in it all day. Just a reminder that P.E kit is a plain white t-shirt (no big logos) navy blue or black shorts, a pair of trainers and plain navy, black or grey joggers (no big logos) when cold. A hoody may be worn when cold in black, grey or navy. **The P.E days are Year 5 Mon, Year 4 Tues, Year 3 Weds, Year 6 Fri.**
