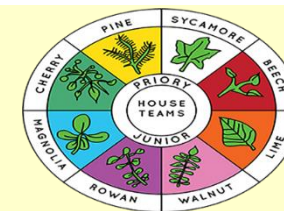

I would like to thank you for supporting the return to school and adapting to the new routines and procedures, I know it is not ideal but essential at this time. A couple of quick reminders.

- **Please do not come to the office unless you have a pre-arranged appointment** - for all other queries please text, e-mail or phone the office.
- **Please stick to the allotted times for pick up and drop off** – Year 3 and 6 8.50 -9.00am and 3.05pm and Year 4 and 5 9.00 -9.10 and 3.15pm. Please do not arrive outside these times as it causes queuing and when you have dropped off and collected your child please leave the area straightaway.
- If you can, to keep our children safe and avoid congestion, **please walk or cycle to school or park further away and walk the last part.**
- **Please keep a 2-metre distance from other families** when waiting to pick up or drop off – **where this is not possible, please wear a face covering.**
- We need to be aware that All Hallows are also running a staggered system so please be courteous to them, avoid blocking their pathways, and leave the school area promptly.
