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

## Dear Families,

Another week at Priory has passed and this week the children proudly wore their t-shirts for the first time during the House assembly. Each House Teacher got to know the children and during the assembly the children revisited what democracy means and then used this to vote for their House Captains. Here at Priory, we want the very best education for your children. A key part of this is ensuring that we work with you to ensure that attendance is as high as possible as every day counts!

## Did you know?

Missing five days of every term every year is the same as missing one whole school year. A child with a good school attendance record is setting themselves up for a better future once they leave school. Children that attend

regularly adapt to the routines of school and make good friendships.

We expect all our children to attend school every day, but also understand that there will be times when your child gets ill. In case of absence please contact school on the first day of absence. We will make a call home if we have not heard by 10am. Wherever possible, please make medical and dental appointments outside of school hours to support.

We aim for attendance of 97% or above. Last years whole school attendance was 94% and we want to improve on this significantly this year. Furthermore, a child is classed as persistently absence if attendance falls below 90%. Last year 16% of children at Priory had attendance below 90%. Children with attendance this low are very likely to fall behind in English and Maths and will struggle as they move through their educational journey.

We are continually monitoring attendance and I will contact families where attendance begins to cause concern so that we can quickly work together to resolve any attendance issues.

This year, children with 100% attendance over the course of a **full term** will receive a special certificate and a badge. We will also recognise attendance over 97% each term too with a certificate. (We know that at this age children do get a few bugs- therefore we break down the Attendance Certificates into terms so that if your child gets ill during one term, they still have the chance for 100% attendance for the following term)

Let's work together to make sure that all children at Priory have high attendance and as a whole school we meet a target of 97%.

We CAN do It!

On a personal note, a huge thank you to the community for their support over the past few weeks. The whole staff team have been incredible and well supported by Miss Edwards with the school in very safe hands. I am looking forward to returning next week and being with our wonderful children once again as I have definitely missed them! I will be around before and after school so please do not hesitate to come and see me for a chat!

97% and Above	Above 97%. Excellent Attendance. Less than 6 days absence a year: Pupils with this attendance should achieve the best grades they can, leading to the best possible start in their junior/secondary education.
95% - 96%	96%. Below Average. Approximately 8 days absence in a year: This means half a year of school is lost over the course of a child's total school career. Pupils with this attendance are below the national average and are less likely to achieve their target grades and less likely to be prepared for starting junior/secondary education.
90%	90%. Too Low! 19 days absence over the year: Pupils with this attendance are missing a month of school per year and are likely to fall behind in Maths and English; it will be very difficult for them to achieve their best. It means that a child will miss a whole year of school if this rate continues across their whole school career. Parents of pupils with this level of attendance could be issued with a Penalty Notice.
85% or less	85%. Serious Problem. 29 days absence in a year: These pupils are missing 6 weeks of school a year. It will be almost impossible for them to keep up with their group and achieve their best. Parents of pupils with this level of attendance will normally be issued with a Penalty Notice.
