This week in school it has been All Together Week (Antibullying Week). We dedicated the week to learning about bullying with the idea that we can put a stop to it by 'Making a Noise' together. Children started the week with their Odd Socks on full display and we celebrated being unique. It was fun to find out the reasons for their sock choices and how much they mean to them - a bit like how much the children mean to us - all special and individual.



Throughout the rest of the week, key messages and themes about bullying were learnt about and discussed through careful class discussions. Children learned about the value of being a kind defender and not a bystander. They explored the difference between retaliation (equal attack) and safe defending (block, report, befriend, speak up). Year 5 scripted their own sock puppet shows using odd socks to outline the definition of bullying in action and how to defend safely. Year 4 made computer generated Wordles to show how to defend and 'Make a Noise' about bullying. Year 6 explored online bullying particularly when 'banter turns to bullying' for example in WhatsApp groups or during online games. Year 3 will be getting to grips with the definition of bullying and how to identify it. Each class used a text in English which explored themes about bullying and our Peace Reps were given a new book about racism to share and enjoy with their class this term. Our week will end on Friday 24th November with a great house competition where teams will be exploring and creating a 'Banter-meter' for each classroom. This is to help children identify when jokes might be taken beyond friendly, consensual banter and turn into bullying that intentionally hurts people and is repeated over time.
